EUROPE4ALL IN SHORT

The project 'Europe4All - European Digital Cultural Heritage and Values for Migrant Empowerment and Inclusion in Adult Education' aims at raising awareness of the diversity of European cultural heritage and values and supporting intercultural dialogue and building mutual understanding between new arrivals and receiving communities. Young learners with and without migration backgrounds work together to create videos documenting and exploring shared experiences. Videos include a wide range of contemporary and historical examples of cultural heritage and its relevance to these experiences. By doing this, learners will stir a conversation on these values.

The project developed practical tools to produce digital films by young adults with and without histories of migration together and materials to give adult educators specific tips on how to use the videos.

LEARNING OBJECTIVES OF EUROPE4ALL PROJECT

- help adult immigrants learn more about the cultural heritage and values shared by people in Europe.
- help (young) adults gain creativity skills through video developing of cultural heritage products.
- improve skills in intercultural communication.
- provide educators and/or non-formal trainers who support adult learners with tools to raise awareness on the importance of Europe's cultural heritage, and values.

Following the development of the <u>Guides and Handouts</u> for filmmaking for beginners and the <u>Video Library</u> with videos produced by migrants and local natives on cultural heritage, partners created the <u>Europe4ALL</u> <u>Handbook for Adult Educators</u>.





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The Handbook strives to equip adult educators and trainers with practical resources for involving learners in discussions surrounding European values and Cultural Heritage and is divided into 5 parts:

- Analysis of the European Values as per the Lisbon Treaty
- Cultural Heritage in Europe
- Examples of good practices in adult education which promote EU values and Cultural Heritage
- Examples of storytelling techniques for promoting EU values and Cultural Heritage
- Didactical frameworks and practical exercises in adult education

A self-assessment tool for educators to assess learners' understanding of EU values and Cultural Heritage as well as lesson plans have also been developed and included in the Handbook.

EUROPE4ALL MULTIMEDIA MANIFESTO

The EUROPE4ALL consortium has developed the Europe4All Manifesto which includes a set of declarations on issues important to local natives and migrants.

The Manifesto presents statements by immigrants and locals in Austria, Cyprus, Germany, Greece, Italy and the Netherlands on issues related to their cultural and social participation through multimedia formats such as videos, images, and audio materials. Interviews at national level have been conducted in each country with individuals to gather statements of:

- In Europe, the following areas need to be improved...
- My suggestion for improving the situation is...
- My message to the Members of the European Parliament...
